Please bring it back by: 9th November 2022

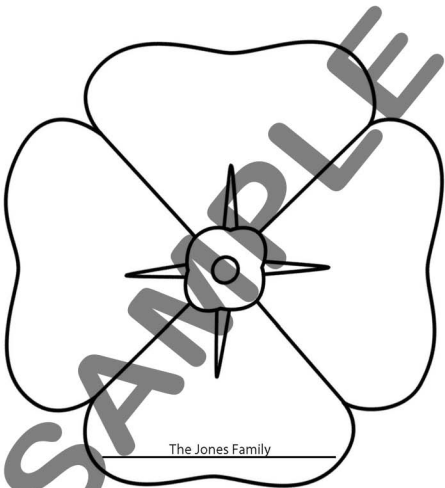
