Summary Of My Learning

- Lily enjoys babbling, clapping, and joining in simple back-and-forth games like peekaboo (Outcome 5: Children are effective communicators).
- She is building physical strength by sitting independently and reaching out for toys with control (Outcome 3: Children have a strong sense of wellbeing).
- Lily shows delight in shared experiences with others, building early social skills through play and eye contact (Outcome 2: Children are connected with and contribute to their world).
