#### Monday

- Children demonstrated increasing control and coordination during fine motor tasks, with noticeable persistence and pride in their creations. Spatial reasoning emerged through trial-and-error, peer collaboration, and verbal problem-solving during construction and puzzle play.

#### Tuesday

Children confidently expressed ideas and negotiated roles, showing growing awareness of turn-taking and respectful dialogue. Group dynamics revealed emerging leadership, empathy, and the ability to resolve conflicts through language.
