#### What I Noticed

During outdoor play, Zara (2.5 years) discovered a patch of wet sand and began pressing her palms into it repeatedly. She then traced lines between the prints and exclaimed, "Look! My hands are dancing!"

### Child's Voice

"Look! My hands are dancing!" "I made a road for the ants!"

## **Emerging Strengths**

- Sense of agency and creativity (Outcome 1.2): Zara initiated her own sensory exploration and expressed delight in her discoveries.
- Communication and symbolic thinking (Outcome 5.3): Her language and metaphor ("hands are dancing") show emerging abstract thinking.

### **Educator Reflection**

Zara's spontaneous play with the sand revealed her growing ability to connect movement, nature, and storytelling. Her narration and symbolic play suggest a readiness forcomplex patterning and mark-making experiences. I was reminded of the importance of slowing down and observing her wonder was contagious.
