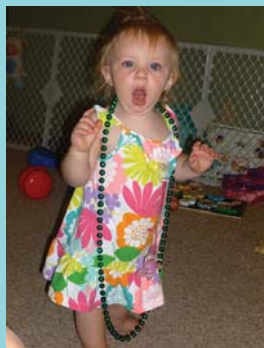


Children Are Effective Communicators
