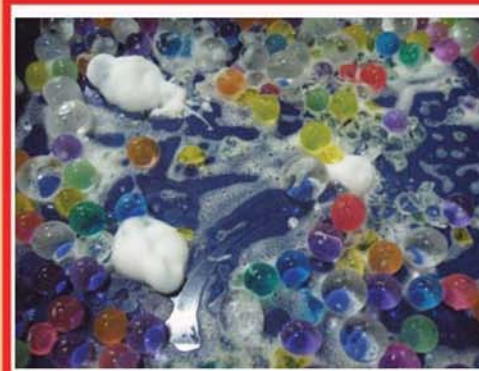

Context

We added water beads to a big bowl of water the day before and this morning they grew into the size of marbles. Maya was so excited she wanted to play them with straight away. I added "snow" (shaving cream) for Maya to manipulate along with the water beads.

Future Planning

Continue sensory experiences with water beads - frozen, in water, mixed with rice.
