Biting Incident

Time: 9:30am

Mark was stacking blocks in block area. Bruce walked over and sat down, next to Mark. Mark shook his head "no". Bruce knocked down the tower of blocks and Mark shouted "no". Bruce took one of the blocks off the floor. Mark leaned over and bit Bruce on the shoulder.

Strategies To Implement:

- Teach simple words for Mark to use when his frustrated.
- Encourage Mark to tell an Educator when a child bothers him.
- Set up individual work area, for children who want to play by themselves.
